Dear Friends and Fellow Astronomers:

This letter is to announce two upcoming Yellowknife Aurora Expeditions to the exclusive Blachford Lake Lodge located on a remote island in the Northwest Territory of Canada. These Tours are being organized and handled by the experienced Arctic Tour Company, ARCTIC ODYSSEYS™. I will be leading these Tours.

The following is a brief summary:

- **Fall Aurora Odyssey to the Northwest Territories:**
 - Dates: August 31 – September 6, 2010: 7 days, 6 nights
 - Cost: \$4,690 from Edmonton, CA
 - Fall is one of the best times to visit Yellowknife. It is not cold yet so there is no "lake fog." You also do not have to take precautions with your photographic equipment. Aurora reflections off the lakes are striking.
 - Take advantage of the incredible pristine wilderness by boat or on foot. Wildlife such as moose, fox, Arctic hare, pine martins and a myriad of Arctic avian, which, in September, are en route to southern destinations for the winter. Though wolf sightings are possible, you will likely hear their howls at night. The full range of rich fall colors will embrace the entire scene – deep purples to bright reds, soft yellows to bold gold. For independent use, canoes and kayaks will be at your disposal to explore the lake and visit hidden beaches. If you are interested in fishing, Blachford Lake is as good as it gets – Northern Pike, Lake Trout and Grayling, of trophy size, are waiting you.
- **Spring Aurora Odyssey to the Northwest Territory**
 - Dates: March 26 – April 1, 2011: 7 days, 6 nights
 - Cost: \$4,690 from Edmonton, CA
 - During the day, you will have a menu of active pursuits from which to choose, including dog sledding, cross-country skiing, snowshoeing, snowmobiling, snow-shelter/igloo building and ice fishing.
- **Comments:**
 - Spring and Fall historically have had the most active Aurora Borealis
 - Blachford Lake Lodge is the finest facility of its kind in the World. It is located east of Yellowknife and north of the Great Slave Lake. It is accessed by a float or ski plane flight from Yellowknife and is completely isolated. There is no light pollution at this remote location. Meals will include fresh baked and northern treats such as Arctic char, caribou, musk ox, lake trout, white fish, berry cake and bannock. After dinner a mini-lecture and/or slide presentations on wildlife, native culture, photography or astronomy will be available.
